**NJFSAB Donates Over \$10,000 to Saint Barnabas Burn Foundation
For Fire Education Outreach**

BRANCHBURG, NJ (June 22, 2007) – Members of the New Jersey Fire Sprinkler Advisory Board (NJFSAB), a cooperative organization that advocates fire safety education and the installation and proper care of fire sprinklers, raised over \$10,000 for the Saint Barnabas Burn Foundation, a fund that supports the only state-certified burn treatment facility in New Jersey.

“We are extremely grateful for this generous donation,” says Beverly Foster, Director of the Saint Barnabas Burn Foundation. “It means even more knowing that it comes from an organization that is so directly related to our cause.”

The donation was raised from proceeds of a fundraiser golf outing hosted with the New Jersey chapter of the National Fire Sprinkler Association. The charity event was held on June 21 at Fox Hollow Golf Course in Branchburg, NJ.
